The [Federal Energy Regulatory Commission](#) (FERC) is the federal government agency that regulates both the construction of interstate natural gas pipelines and the transportation of natural gas in interstate commerce.

It is the lead agency approving and overseeing the Bison Project. In this role, FERC coordinates the participation of many other state and federal agencies that must review relevant parts of the project – such as the Environmental Protection Agency and the U.S. Department of Transportation's Office of Pipeline Safety. FERC also oversees the public participation process, to ensure that affected citizens are informed and have the opportunity to be heard.
